Help sheet for Year 4 maths

Before you start, look carefully at the Knowledge Organiser - remember to keep using it to help you through the week! For each of these sheets, there are two sets on a page so only do one (!) and the questions get harder as you go down - hopefully most of you can get to the second set at least.

| Monday - <br> 1 | Have your Knowledge Organiser ready to help. Remember $1 \mathrm{hr}=60$ minutes; 1 <br> minute $=60$ seconds. Remember that $1 / 2$ a minute is 30 seconds. |
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| Tuesday - <br> 2 | Have your Knowledge Organiser ready to help. When comparing, make sure each <br> one is in the same unit - you might have to convert them before comparing. A <br> calendar might be helpful! |
| Wednesday <br> -3 | Have your Knowledge Organiser ready to help. Make sure you check if you are <br> using a.m. or p.m. Think about how the time is written in words. |
| Thursday - <br> 4 | Have your Knowledge Organiser ready to help. Converting with the $24-$ hour clock. <br> Remember that for the p.m. times it changes: $1 \mathrm{pm}=1300 ; 2 \mathrm{pm}=1400 ; 3 \mathrm{pm}=1500$ <br> etc. Make sure you check if you are using a.m. or p.m. |
| Friday -5 | Create your own knowledge organiser using what you have learnt this week. |
